## **Procedure Card for IDT0750**

## **PARACETAMOL IDENTIFICATION**

**Substance Test** 



Read Before Use

As a precaution, gloves and eye protection should be worn when handling drug substances and using test units. Do not protective any part of unit. Do not remove probe once a capsule is broken. In the unlikely event of a spill, rinse affected area thoroughly with water. Keep out of reach of children. All results are presumptive. If necessary, further testing by a competent drug testing lab can provide additional identification.

## Remove the Smart-Tip<sup>TM</sup> **Test Preparation** probe from test unit.

Sample suspected substance. Powder

Tablet

Touch Smart-Tip<sup>TM</sup> probe to sample.

Firmly press Smart-Tip<sup>TM</sup> probe on the tablet while scrubbing in a circular motion until the tip is completely covered with substance.



**Test Preparation** 



Do not continue unless probe is locked below the Flex Pins and cannot e removed from the test unit

Identification



Gently shake test unit for 2-3 seconds.



**Results** 



The appearance of a rose to orange-red color indicates the presence of Paracetamol.



If no rose to orange-red color develops, Paracetamol is not present.



Proceed to Dilution (steps 6-9), regardless of whether or not a color appeared.



With thumb and forefinger, squeeze chamber 2 until capsule breaks.




Gently shake test unit for 2-3 seconds.



Wait 5 minutes. The test window will warm up. This is normal.

Dilution





Gently shake test unit for 2-3 seconds.



The test window will warm up. This is normal.

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Disposal

After Dilution, the test kit is safe to dispose of in the trash.



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
