

Synthetic Cannabinoids Test Kits

Read Before Use As a precaution, gloves and eye protection should be worn when handling substances and using test units. Do not puncture any part of unit. Do not remove probe after breaking the ampule. In event of a spill, rinse affected area thoroughly with water. Keep out of reach of children. Store the tubes in a dark place, not exposed to light. All results are presumptive. If necessary, further testing by a competent drug testing lab can provide additional identification.

Fest Preparation

Remove the SWIPPERTM Cap from the test unit.

Ensure that the test tube remains upright in order to avoid the ampule falling out of the tube.

Sample the suspected substance with the SWIPPERTM Cap.

Return the SWIPPERTM Cap to the test tube. Press firmly.



Do not continue unless the SWIPPERTM Cap

is properly secured.

With thumb and forefinger, squeeze the test tube until the ampule breaks.

Gently shake test up and down to ensure that the liquid touches the Cap.

 The test will not react to the following substances: Classical cannabinoids, nonclassical cannabinoids, phenylacetylindoles.



Dilute the acid with some tap water before disposing the kit in the trash.
